- Check your water line connections and faucets for leaks
- Check water flow rates for showerheads, washing machines, toilets, faucets, and dishwashers

- Review your residential water usage
- Provide rebate information

Since you don't receive your water bill directly, it's sometimes easy to forget how much water you use doing the simple things: washing dishes, letting the faucet run so the water is just a bit warmer, or soaking in a hot bath at the end of the day. - Run the washing machine and dishwasher only when they are full.

- Put a bucket in the shower to catch the water while you're waiting for it to warm up, and use it to water plants, mop floors, or to give your pets a drink.
- Install water efficient shower heads.
